# **BGVH – Cinema - Terms of Admission**

### **Films**

Entry to films is restricted by the classification given by the British Board of Film Classification or others. We are required to refuse admission to anyone who is below the minimum age required by the relevant classification.

- Anyone can be admitted to films classified as U or PG.
- Children under 12 can be admitted to films classified as 12A but only if accompanied by an adult (i.e. someone over the age of 18).
- Nobody under the age of 15 can be admitted to films classified as 15.
- Nobody under the age of 18 can be admitted to films classified as 18.

## Children 16 years old or under must be accompanied by a parent or guardian for all films.

## General

- We reserve the right to ask you to prove your age with appropriate photographic ID if you are going to 12, 15 or 18 film or purchasing an alcoholic drink. If you are unable to prove your age you will not be able to watch the film or buy an alcoholic drink.
- No alcoholic drinks may be brought into the village hall.
- You must not smoke inside the village hall.
- Mobile phones must be switched off or in a silent mode before you enter the auditorium.
  You must not take or make calls inside the auditorium.
- It is a serious criminal offence to copy or attempt to copy any film or other copyright material exhibited in any part of the cinema, punishable on conviction with an unlimited fine and imprisonment of up to a maximum of ten years. You are not permitted to bring cameras and/or recording equipment of any kind into the cinema. You must not use your mobile phone / mobile devices to record the film.
- You must adhere with any health and safety procedures or instructions that are in place and notified to you by our staff or by notices.
- We accept no responsibility for any personal property that is brought to a cinema.

### **Refusal of admission**

We reserve the right to refuse admission or require you to leave the premises without a refund if you:

- Behave in an anti-social or threatening manner
- Put the safety of our customers, our volunteers or our property at risk
- Bring a camera or recording equipment of any kind into the cinema
- Otherwise breach our Terms of Admission.
